labour.



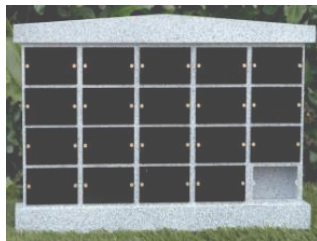
CONFIRMATION PROGRAM REGISTRATION – Rev Bill wishes to announce that our

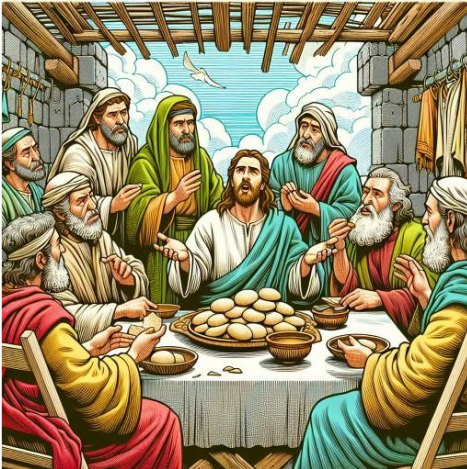
CHURCH OFFERTORY OPTIONS – In addition to our *Sunday collection plate*:

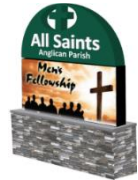
