WE ARE SEARCHING FOR OLD PHOTOGRAPHS TAKEN DURING THE CONSTRUCTION OF OUR CHURCH – Back in 1928 the Mission of Foxtrap was raised to the status



of a Parish. In that same year, Rev H.V. Whitehouse emphasized the need for us to build a new Church. This project was lead by William Henry Batten and a Mr Stevens, both from Bareneed, with most of the work completed by free labour. Our corner stone was laid on June 07, 1931, with the first service being held on November 27, 1932. If you have any photos of this construction, we ask if you

CHURCH OFFERTORY OPTIONS – In addition to our *Sunday collection plate*:

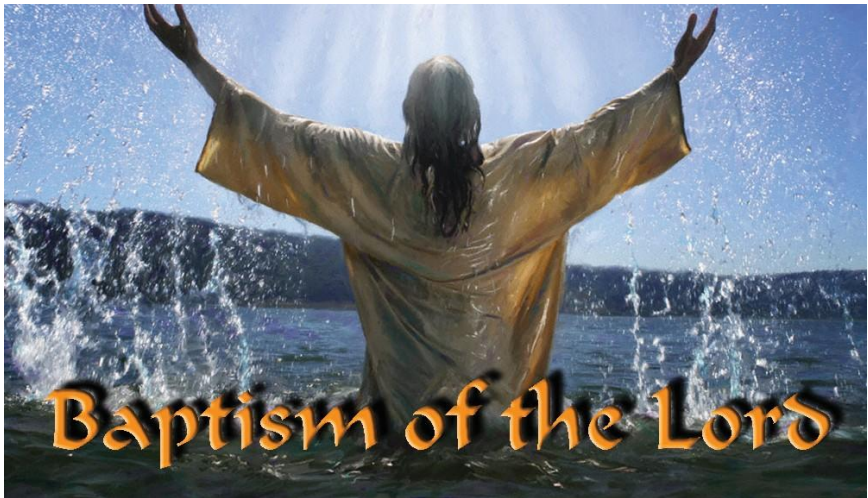


- Our *secure drop-slot*, located to the left of the Parish Hall main door, which is emptied daily, is available 7/24
