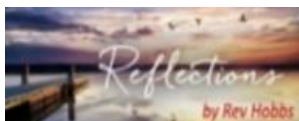

OF OUR CHURCH – Back in 1928 the Mission of Foxtrap was raised to the status of a Parish. In that same year, Rev H.V. Whitehouse emphasized the need for us to build a new Church. This project was lead by William Henry Batten and a Mr Stevens, both from Bareneed, with most of the work completed by free labour. Our corner stone was laid on June 07, 1931, with the first service being held on November 27, 1932.
