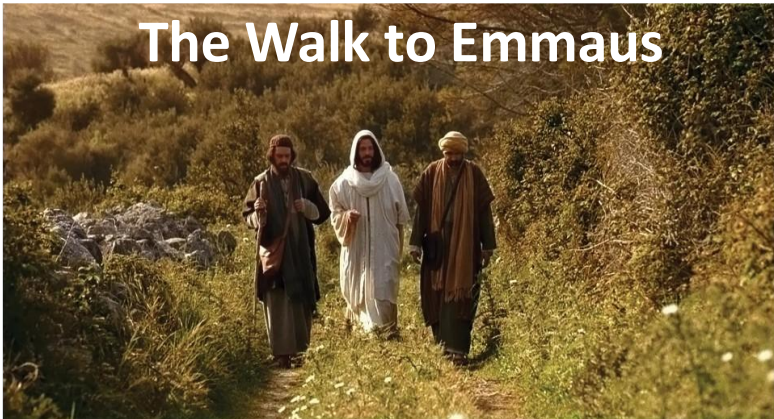

The "Road to Emmaus" is a biblical story (Luke 24:13-35) where two disciples, traveling from Jerusalem after Jesus' crucifixion, encounter the risen Christ, whom they initially fail to recognize. It symbolizes moving from despair to understanding, spiritual awakening, and recognizing Jesus' presence in daily life, culminating in the "breaking of bread", symbolizing communion. It is often used to describe a spiritual journey or a time of "walking with Christ" through difficult questions.
