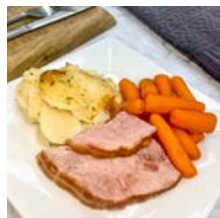

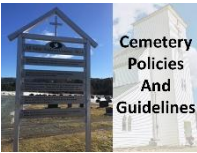

CEMETERY UPDATE – It's that time of year when we restart our ongoing cemetery maintenance activities, and we would like to welcome back Stephen Porter, our Cemetery Supervisor.

As you may or may not know, All Saints has five separate cemetery properties, and we maintain the graves of over 3700 souls – our departed family members. This task gets more challenging each year, and so we would like to point out a few areas where you, our Parishioners, can help us ease some of the burden.

Our first priority for the season is to ensure we have all our properties cleaned up after the throws of winter, and in a respectable condition for our upcoming Mother's Day celebrations. This entails removing a lot of old flowers and ornaments that have weltered, broken, or been blown around the property, creating not only an eyesore, but a safety hazard.



Which brings us to a few reminders of some important sections of our ***Cemetery Policies and Guidelines*** document located at the top of our website. With such a large volume of graves spread over such widespread properties, it is imperative that we all act responsibly.

- Nothing is permitted to be planted on a grave plot
- Every effort should be made to place flowers and any other items of respect directly on the monument base itself, or areas as near to the base as possible, but never exceeding six inches away from the monument base. Any such items may be discarded, without notice.
- Cut flowers and potted plants may only be placed in disposable clay or plastic containers. **Glass containers are absolutely not permitted** within our cemeteries, and will be discarded, without notice.
- Ornaments made of glass, ceramic, plastic, wood, or metal are not permitted, as they tend to clutter the gravesites and interfere with general maintenance. **Any such items that are considered a safety hazard or which interfere with general maintenance, especially grass cutting, may be moved or discarded**, without notice.
- Last year, at the peak of the fire season, we had to remove all solar powered lighting because there were occasions when such devices were responsible for starting some grass fires. As this season progresses, we may have to enact such measures once more. We will send out notices and post on our website and Facebook page.
- Please expect to receive a few notices throughout the summer season requesting your volunteer assistance with a few projects such as mowing, and monument maintenance, etc..
