PENTECOST - also called Whit Sunday - is a Christian holiday that takes place on



the 49th day after Easter. Pentecost is a profoundly transformative event, celebrated as the "birthday of the Church". It commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and followers of Jesus in Jerusalem. Beyond its historical roots, its deeper meaning lies in the shift from external laws to inward empowerment, marking a new covenant of grace for humanity. Pentecost signifies the completion of the Paschal Mystery (Christ's passion, death, resurrection, and ascension). The timid Apostles are suddenly transformed into bold witnesses, moving Christianity from a private movement into a public, global mission. It represents the unleashing of the same spiritual power into the world today to bring healing, wisdom, and guidance.

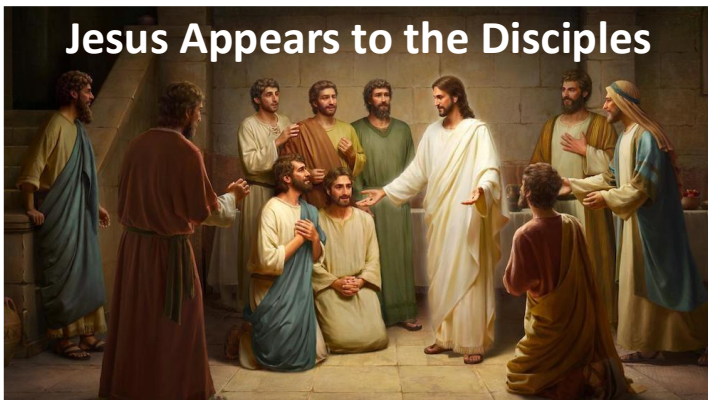
