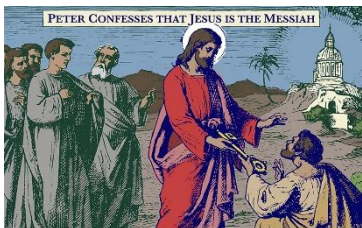

CEMETERY END-OF-SEASON - We are approaching our end-of-the-season (**September 30th**) activities within our cemeteries. We would like to remind everyone to ensure all grave ornaments are removed by then, as these often become hazardous and unsightly when they blow about our cemeteries and onto neighbouring properties. **In early October, those items not removed will be discarded without further notice** by the Cemetery Team.



The confession of Peter, where he acknowledges Jesus as the Messiah, is a pivotal moment in the New Testament, highlighting the recognition of Jesus' divine identity by His closest followers. This event is recorded in the Synoptic Gospels, with the most detailed account found in Matthew

16:13-20. The confession takes place in the region of Caesarea Philippi, a location known for its pagan worship and diverse religious influences. It is here, amidst a backdrop of competing deities and beliefs, that Jesus poses a critical question to His disciples: "Who do people say the Son of Man is?" The disciples respond with various answers, reflecting the public's perception of Jesus as John the Baptist, Elijah, Jeremiah, or one of the prophets.

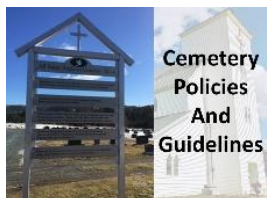

CEMETERY UPDATE – Here are a few reminders of some important sections of our ***Cemetery Policies and Guidelines*** document located at the top of our website.



- Nothing is permitted to be planted on a grave plot
- Every effort should be made to place flowers and other items of respect directly on the monument base itself, never exceeding six inches away from the monument base. These items may be discarded without notice.
- Cut flowers and potted plants may only be placed in disposable clay or plastic containers. **Glass containers are absolutely not permitted** anywhere within our cemeteries, and will be discarded without notice.
- Ornaments made of glass, ceramic, plastic, wood, or metal are not permitted, as they tend to clutter the gravesites and interfere with general maintenance. **Any such items that are considered a safety hazard or which interfere with general maintenance, especially grass cutting, may be moved or discarded** without notice.
- Last year at the peak of the fire season, we had to remove all solar powered lighting because there were occasions when such devices were responsible for starting some grass fires. As this upcoming season progresses, we may have to enact such measures once again. If possible, we will place a notice in The Candle, on our website and Facebook page, and on our digital road sign.
- Please expect to receive a few notices throughout the summer season requesting your volunteer assistance with a few projects such as mowing grass before the Flower Services, and monument maintenance, etc..
