My Dear Friends,

In light of our Bishop's directive given last evening, I wish to address our parish today with some further guidance as it pertains to All Saints.

Although Sunday physical gatherings for in person worship are suspended for now, I encourage you to join us online at <u>www.allsaintsparish.ca</u> for our pre recorded Sunday service.

The gathering around the word of God is paramount to the Christian. Our souls need constant nourishment from the scriptures and our rich Anglican liturgies certainly provide that.

Please note, that Sunday's upcoming online service was pre recorded prior to the Bishop's directive last evening. Therefore, it will not reflect the events of this. That said, as we are now about to enter Lent, we will be pre recording the Ash Wednesday Liturgy.

I encourage the parish family to watch this at 7pm on Ash Wednesday as we begin our annual penitential journey. A time when we inwardly search our hearts and look to make changes, if necessary, through scripture, prayer and grace.

I know online worship is not the same as in person. However, I would encourage you to come with thankful hearts, in that we still have this medium available to use and truly thank God for this!
